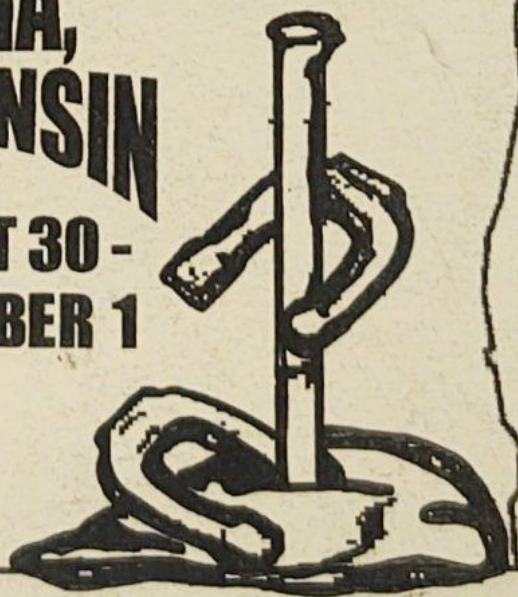

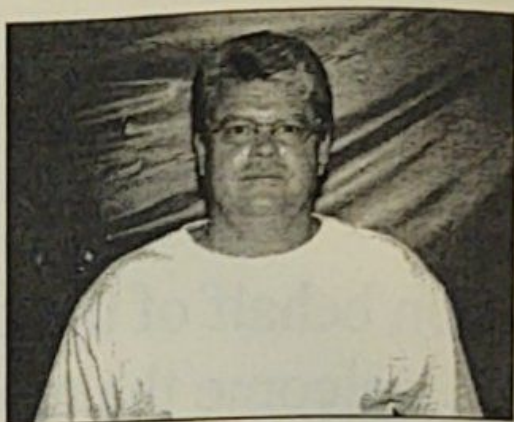

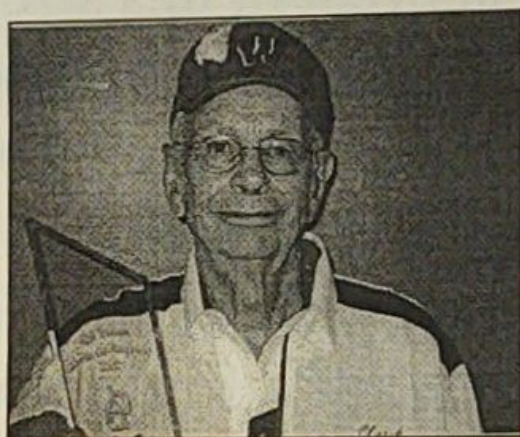

WHPA SPECIAL AWARDS

The Pitcher of the Year Award was created by then President Dick Hansen with the intention of encouraging members to participate in State sanctioned tournaments. In 1994 Dick handed the record keeping duties to Jane Smith with the suggestion to simplify the points, as over 275 pitchers were listed, and the record keeping job was time consuming. The calculations now include only NHPA sanctioned tournaments and points awarded for only first (15 points), second (10 points) and third (5 points) finishers.

The President's Award was also created by Dick Hansen in 1993 with the intention of recognizing a person or persons who have greatly contributed to the promotion and success of the game of horseshoe.

The Scorekeeper's Award was created by Marge Yach and Randy Rein in 1997. Their experience in hosting a weekend tournament impressed upon them the important role scorekeepers play in the success of a tournament. Horseshoe pitchers are asked to help in the selection of this winner by contacting Marge or Randy with the "scorekeeper" and reasons for this recognition. Winners of the award can repeat every five years.

The Most Improved WHPA Pitchers Award was given for the first time at the 2000 State Tournament. This award will be given to the person who has improved his/her pitching average the most over the past year (August 1 – July 31) at the same pitching distance.

SCORE KEEPING GUIDELINES

1. Please write the **LOWEST** number on the left side of the score sheet and place the name of the **LOWEST** number on the top of the scoreboard. (Consistency)
2. Display the score change on the scoreboard **BEFORE** writing it on the score sheet – especially the final score. (Pitchers can immediately check score and movement won't interfere with the pitchers.)
3. Rotate your scoreboard occasionally so all spectators can see the score.
4. Sign your score sheet.
5. Tie games in 50 shoe games are broken by pitching 4 more shoes until the tie is broken.
6. Ask the pitchers to wait at the **END** of the courts for their cards after the game. You will bring the information to them. (to eliminate distractions for pitchers on adjacent courts.)

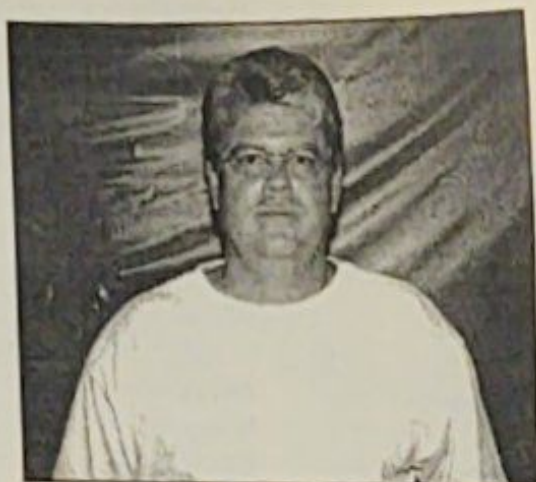

HALL OF FAME

The Wisconsin Horseshoe Pitchers Hall of Fame has three categories: Player, Promoter, and Player/Promoter. To be eligible for Hall of Fame selection, candidates must have been a member of the WHPA for ten years. The WHPA also has an Honorary Hall of Fame, established in 1998, for persons who have made an impressive impact on the game of horseshoes in our state. Nominations, including the nominees horseshoe history, are sent to Hall of Fame Chairperson, Edith McKinney by February 1st. Nominee names are left on the selection list for ten years. The Hall of Fame committee meets before the Spring Meeting to choose Hall of fame member/s to be recognized and inducted at the Awards Ceremony at the State Tournament. The Hall of Fame plaques are then hung in the Hall of Fame display cabinets in Arena following the Fall Meeting. The committee members are the five WHPA officers and three at large members: Edie McKinney, Jeff Secord, and Dick Hansen.

2003 WHPA HALL OF FAME
Randy Rein



Randy was born in 1952 and has lived in Mosinee his entire life. He has been employed for the City of Mosinee (Street Department) since September of 1972. Randy has two sons, Shannon and Wesley. Randy first started pitching horseshoes in 1982 in bar leagues pitching the "flip" shoe with no step. After watching Harold Bestul and Wally Srenaski compete in Plover, which made a great impression on Randy, he then went to a turn and a quarter shoe. Both of Randy's two sons also pitch horseshoes. They both have won the Jr. Boy's State Championship Title. Shannon won the Boy's Title in 1994 and Wesley in 1996 and 2001. In 1990 Randy met Marge Yach. With her encouragement and support his game has gone to the next level where it is now. Randy and Marge have started a Mini Storage business where they manage 72 units and they also rent out apartments. When Randy is not pitching horseshoes he also enjoys hunting, riding his Harley Davidson motorcycles and snowmobiling. One of his most enjoyable rides was a trip that he and Marge took to the Sturgis Rally in South Dakota in 2002.

Randy has won eight Men's State Championship Titles since 1990. He has also competed in numerous World Tournaments, where he has four top ten finishes in the Men's Championship Class (6th, 9th twice and 10th). In 1985 he took a 1st in Class H at LaFayette, Indiana, in 1986 he came up 2nd in Class D in Ainsworth, Nebraska. Then in 1991 he captured a first in Class B1 in Biloxi, Mississippi and in 2001 he placed 1st again in Class A2 in Hibbing, Minnesota. Randy's average has qualified him to participate on the #1 Wisconsin team for Team World since 1990. He has won the Pitcher of the Year award five times. In 1999 he won the State Doubles Championship with partner Gus Schram and again in 2003 with Jim Larson. He has been a Wisconsin Club Team participant, winning in 1990 for Wausau and 1993 for Windy Hill. His highest tournament was a 79%. Randy's best game pitched was in Eau Claire against Rick Poppe with 33 ringers out of 34 shoes. The "Scorekeeper of the Year" award was started by Randy and Marge in 1997, which they both still give out.

Randy enjoys pitching horseshoes and has meet many nice people and developed many friendships over the years. His most memorable experience was at the State Tournament in Eau Claire in 1994. There he won the Men's State Title and his son Shannon won the Jr. Boy's State Title, while Wesley won the Jr. Boy's Class A Title. What an accomplishment for father and sons! Congratulations Randy!
