The Srenaskis have returned, with trophies, from the 1991 World Horseshoe Tournament at Biloxi, Mississippi. Cyrena's is for second place in Senior Women Championship Class, and Wally's for first in Intermediate Men Class, A. CONGRATULATIONS!!!

WALLY AND CYRENA SRENASKI

In 1939, at the age of 13, Wally Srenaski won the Green Bay City Junior Boys Ringers Championship. Two years later, when Cyrena Shaha was 13, she helped win the City Girls Doubles Championship. A few years later Wally and Cy met on a blind date arranged by his brother and her sister. There was an attraction there because after Wally and his brother Ed served in the navy during World War II, the Srenaski brothers married the Shaha sisters.

It was about 20 years later, in 1966, that an interest in horseshoe pitching was revived when Wally read about Carl Joppe winning the State Tournament at the Fairgrounds in Milwaukee. He then rushed out, put a couple of stakes in a vacant lot behind their home, and convinced Cy to come out to practice with him. Wally got his start at the Green Bay Horseshoe Club when a friend asked him to sub. Cy started league pitching when she and Wally helped form the couples league which has been playing for fifteen years. They have been couples league champions eleven out of fourteen tries. They are both members of the Green Bay Club Team that participates in the State Club Team Tournament every year. Their team was the first to win the tourney twice, 1987 and 1989.

When Swen Bowman died, Wally and Cy virtually took over the Green Bay club, not only interested in bettering their games, but in holding the leagues together through some very difficult times. Wally served five years as club president while Cy was secretary for seven years. During Wally's tenure in office the club grew by 50% due to his special efforts to recruit new members. They have run Green Bay Swen's Open since 1974 and State Tournaments in 1982 and 1985. Wally was instrumental in finding a new home for the club at the Watering Hole.

Cyrena won the 1977 State Class B honors, many class A titles and second places. In 1987 she placed sixth in Class B Ladies in the World Tournament in Eau Claire. At 1989 World in Spearfish, SD, she was successful in taking first place in the Ladies Senior Division. Her comment was, "This is probably the biggest thrill I'll ever have as a horseshoe pitcher." Cy is also a good bowler, usually averaging between 180 and 185.

Wally placed third in Class C Intermediate Men's in the 1989 World. He won Class A in the 1985 Winnebagoland Open while Cy took Class A Women, the first time a husband and wife won Class A in the same tournament. Wally also won several Class B tournaments, plus many lower classes. Together Wally and Cy enter as many open tournaments as possible and have accumulated numerous trophies.

Wally worked as a machinist at Paper Converting Machine Company for 36 years and retired on March 23, 1990. Cy was an Administrative Specialist at NCR Corporation for 23 years prior to her retirement on October 1, 1990.

Wally and Cyrena are the parents of four sons and three daughters; there are ten grandchildren and one great-grandchild. Their daughters Sue Vine and Kim Felton and their husbands also pitch horseshoes and do very well. Wally and Cy will be celebrating their 45th wedding anniversary on September 14. Their home address is 1212 Chantel Street, Green Bay, Wisconsin 54304.

The Green Bay Horseshoe Club is justifiably proud and appreciative of all that Wally and Cy have done for horseshoe pitching in Green Bay.

CHARLES P. CHRISTOPLIS

Charles P. Christoplis, better known as Charly, started pitching horseshoes at the age of 50. He describes himself as a workaholic in his early years, building a couple of homes and a cottage, working as a barber and in other trades, starting in iron work in 1959. He retired at age 62 after fifteen years of that because he "began getting a little stiff jumping from beam to beam in the air."

Charly started pitching in a tavern league and, in 1968, entered his first tournament at State Fair Park. "Little did I know what I was getting into", he says. He qualified number two in class B before noon on Saturday, sat from 11:00 AM Saturday, all afternoon, all evening, until 11:30 at night to get onto the courts, then waited another half hour for a scorekeeper. He ended up in fourth place and returned home at 5:00 AM Sunday morning - needless to say, to a not too happy wife!

After this introduction to tournament pitching Charly still liked the game and brought up the idea of having their own tournament in Sheboygan. He pitched in the Combined Locks tournament the following year and then, with advice from Swen Bowman and others, they held their first tournament on two courts. The following year two courts were added, with lights and fences. Charly was the inspiration behind the success of the Sheboygan tournaments and, with the hard work and dedication of the league members, conducted yearly tournaments for about 17 years.

Charly says that through the years he had some good and some not so good averages - from mid 30's to high 40's, and some tournaments even 50 to 56%. He remembers one game of 78%. He pitched in about 95 tournaments and his wife Irma accompanied him to most of them. They have enjoyed meeting a lot of good people through the years.

Charly and Irma, who have been married 54 years, have three children, eight grandchildren, and six great-grandchildren. They were lifelong residents of Sheboygan until May 16, 1991 when they moved to California where they have a son in Anaheim. Their address is 680 Bahama Drive, Hemet, CA 92343.

Charly is keeping in practice by pitching on courts about ten minutes drive from their home and hopes to pitch in more tournaments. He and Irma will be missed by their many Wisconsin friends.
