Carl Pfeffer is also being honored by the Wisconsin Horseshoe Pitchers Association with a Hall-of-Fame award for 1981.

Carl started playing horseshoes in 1933. He won the Class B title at the Auer Cove Playground tournament in 1934, and the Major AAA title in 1937, '38, and '39. He entered the state tournament for the first time in 1934, qualified in class A and placed second. He won the state championship in 1956 and 1958.

He has been a member of the Washington Park Club for 45 years, winning the club tournament twice and the handicap tournament twice. He is also a member of the Tri-County league.

Carl, who is "74 years young", worked for American Motors Corporation for 44 years and has been retired from the Master Mechanic Department for eleven years. He was a member of a six brothers bowling team from 1946 to 1956. He has a family of two sons, eight grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. Carl lives at 5812 W.
