**Behind the Mask  
With NHPA Chaplain**

**Ken Heinritz**



“Get the shoe on & hit it dead center. That’s about it. That’s all you need to know.” Those were the parting words of advice from the inventor of the Ringle Single, Gus Schram. He was nontraditional.

For Gus, horseshoe pitching all started at the age of 50 years old, because he needed exercise for an ailing bad back. So he pounded in some stakes & the rest is history. Pitching only 15 years Gus turned his attention to fishing.

This man enjoyed leaving his mark on whatever he did . . . hunting, archery & boat trailers. Fortunately for the WHPA, Gus entered the horseshoe world.

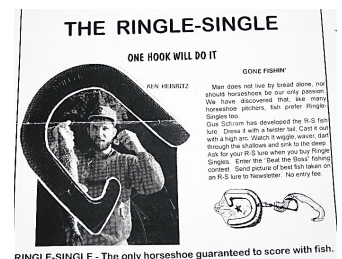
With 9 years in Gus started toying with the idea of making shoes. He showed up at a tournament in Beloit with a replica of Ted Allen shoes, only these were made out of aluminum bronze material. With the encouragement of Jim Haupt, a new sanctioned shoe would soon appear on the scene. Now what would the man from Ringle, Wisconsin come up with for his single-hooked shoe? The Ringle Single was the perfect name. Gus laughed as he said if he had lived in nearby Hatley it would have been called the “Hatley Hooker”.

Of course for me, a conversation with the Ringle Single legend was a memorable one. Who knows where my career would have gone if not for the Ringle Single. For the past 12 years, this ‘one-armed bandit’ has been the shoe of my choice. My World Tournament opponents & I enjoy the yearly

bantering that goes on because of my secret weapon. Of special interest for me was the Ringle Single fish-  
ing lure Gus had dangling on his cowboy hat. If it weren’t for that lure, I probably would have never picked up the shoe. A lure made by Gus was passed out to the pitchers at an Arena tournament, I promptly landed a 28 inch northern pike in Canada just months later. At the end of that year, Gus shook my hand & handed me a pair of Ringle Singles for catching the biggest fish of the year.

Thank you Gus.

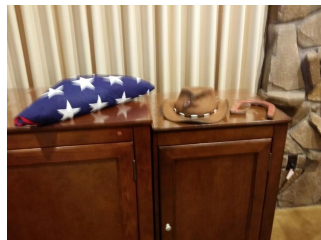

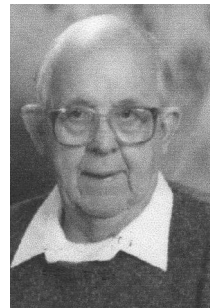
## Penny Steinke Update
