



## ANNOUNCING

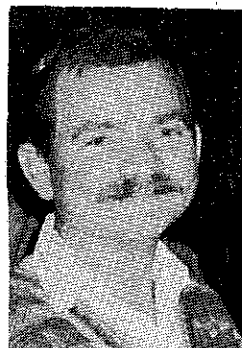

It started out as match partners by high and low percentages but some pitchers wanted to find their own guy or gal for the other end. A limit system was devised. Team entries were accepted as long as the total did not exceed 110%. Other single entries were assigned to class by precentage and then matched high and low. If you're willing there's a way.

By way of comparison with the V.F.W. affair, both pitch 40 shoes, per pitcher each game; for both its mark your own score; and class size varied from four to seven teams. Beloit had 78 pitchers; the V.F.W.88 The main difference is unrestricted team entry at the V.F.W. and the 110% limit in Beloit and the separate Women's class at the V.F.W.

Someday there may be some interaction between Earl Paulson of Beloit and Don Navarrete of Combined Locks. Both scheduled class A at 1:00 Saturday.

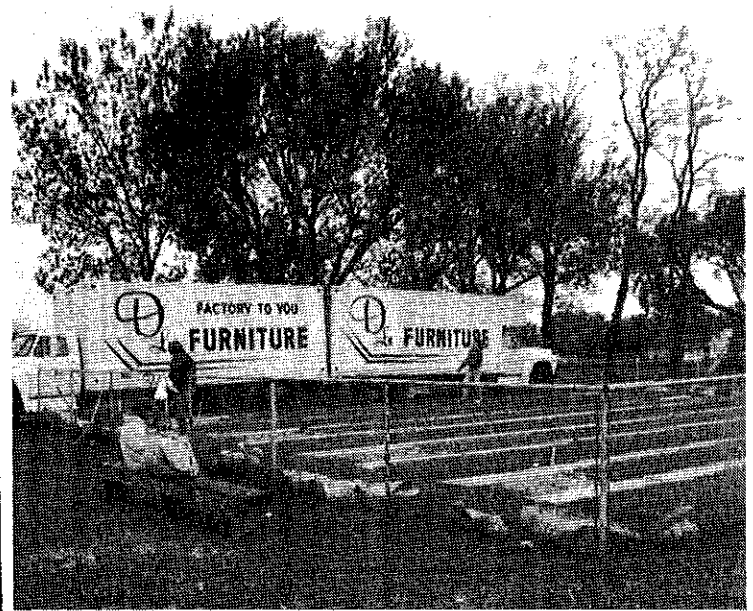
**BELOIT\*JANESVILLE OPEN**

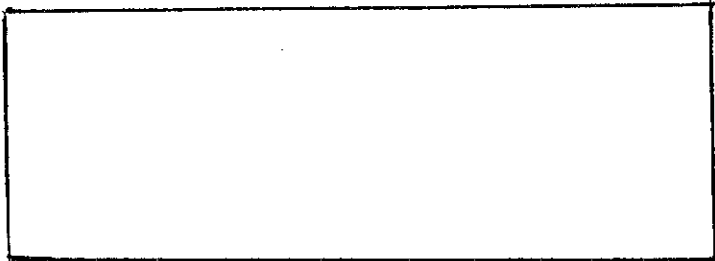

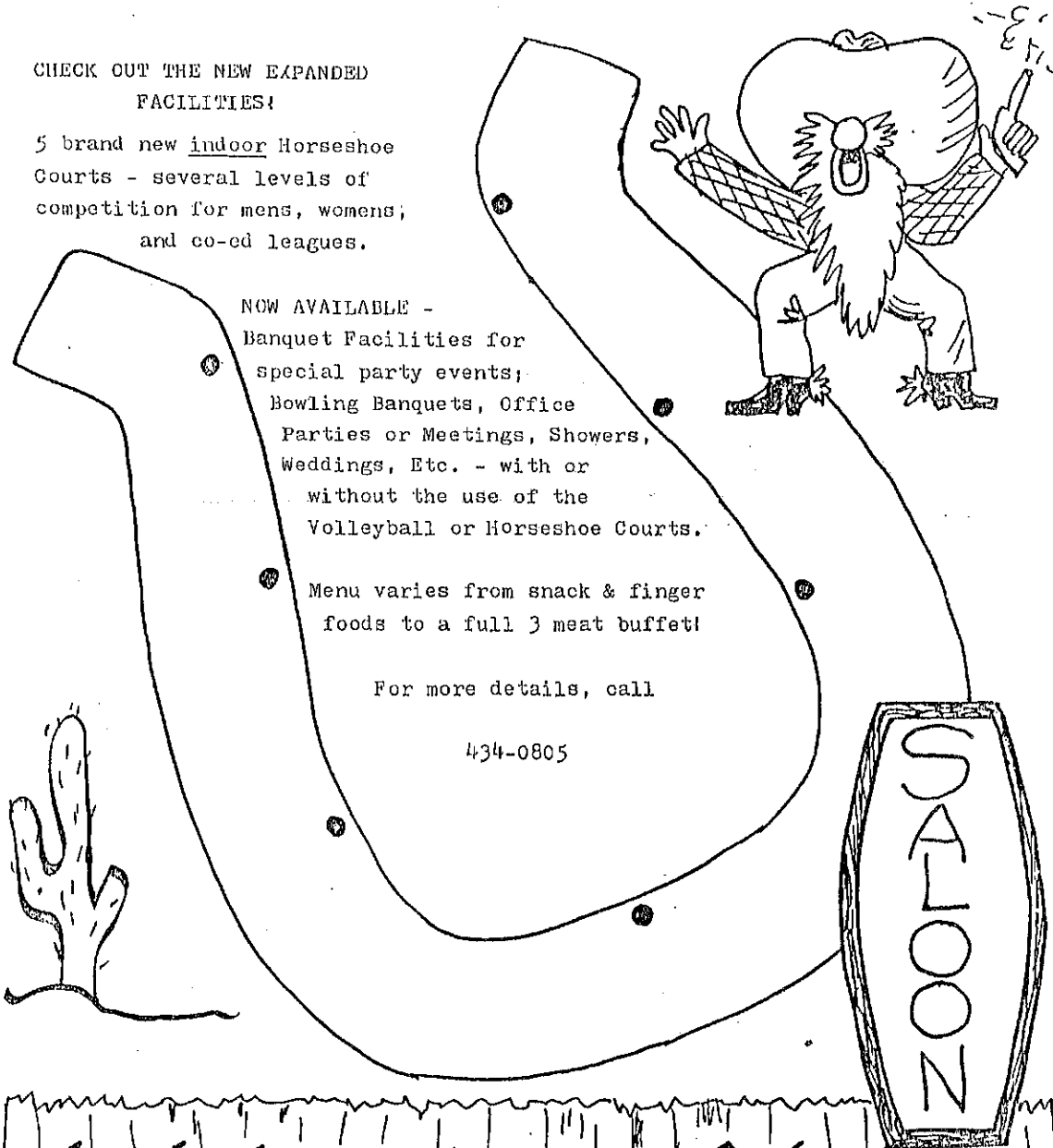
