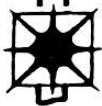



ART J. KLEMENT

Art J. Klement is being honored, posthumously, with the Wisconsin Horseshoe Pitchers Association Hall-of-Fame award for 1982.

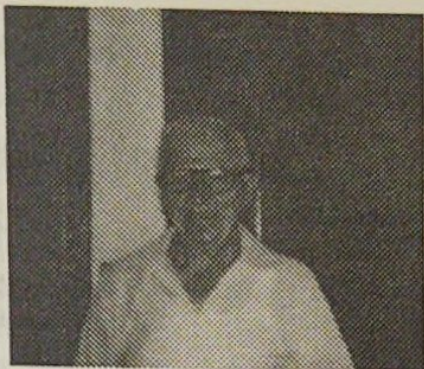
Art Klement served as president of the Wisconsin Horseshoe Pitchers Association for 36 years, from 1925 through 1961, except for the 1948 season. During his years as president he always ran the State Tournament at State Fair Park with much authority which was respected by all participants and State Fair park officials.

Art was always willing to help organize new clubs, helping with leagues, running tournaments, etc. He also participated in league play with the West Allis Club and enjoyed playing with and against all his fellow horseshoe pitchers in and around Milwaukee. After moving to Fort Atkinson he was the driving force in launching and operating the Fort Atkinson Club, where he also played and ran tournaments until his death. He was well liked by all horseshoe pitchers.

He was involved in organizing the World Tournament in Miami, Florida in 1923 and 1924.

Art Klement died July 2, 1962 at the age of 74. He is survived by one son, Jon, of Fort Atkinson. His son Bob, who at one time was secretary-treasurer of the State Association, passed away in August of 1981.

There is no doubt that Art J. Klement's many years of effort and devotion to Wisconsin horseshoe pitching has earned him a place in the Wisconsin Horseshoe Pitchers Hall-of-Fame.



### EDDIE SCHIMEK

One of two 1982 Wisconsin Horseshoe Pitchers Association Hall-of-Fame awards is being presented to Edward J. "Eddie" Schimek.

Eddie Schimek started pitching horseshoes in 1925, participating in the state tournament in 1928 for the first time, and for the next 40 years, at State Fair Park. He took part in three more state contests at different locations. He won the state championship in 1960, '62 and '63. The "National Horseshoe Pitchers' News Digest" featured his picture on the cover of the November 1963 issue. He won the Mideastern at Combined Locks in 1966, and he was City of Milwaukee champion in 1931 and 1948. He was a charter member of the Auer Avenue Horseshoe Club and helped organize the City League. He was president of the club in 1935 and a member for 17 years, and a member of the Washington Park Horseshoe Club for 24 years, winning the Washington Park Class A Championship in 1959.

In 1948, when the World Tournament was held in West Allis, Ed was honored to be asked to practice with Guy Zimmerman. They played three games and Ed won one of them 50-37, with 82.6%. He failed to qualify for the World Tournament by 15 points; Guy went on to pitch the first perfect game in a World tourney and ended up in third place.

Ed also had the pleasure of winning a couple of games from Casey Jones. He appeared twice on WTMJ-TV in 1957 in a show called "Pitching Horseshoes." In 1948 he took part in a Red Cross program at Wood Hospital where he coached the veterans for several weeks, giving them pointers in pitching shoes. He also gave out the trophies after the tournament they had at the end of the season.

Since retiring in 1976 as supervisor in the Cost Accounting Department at Johnson Controls, Ed has kept busy playing dartball at Washington Park Senior Center. He is one of the top dartball players in Milwaukee and has received individual awards for highest average, always 500 or better, in the years 1976 through 1981. He bowls in two senior leagues and was on the team that won the championship in 1978, '79, and '80. He compiled the highest average in both leagues, a composite average of 175 the last two years.

Ed was born July 25, 1911 in Milwaukee. He and his wife Katherine, who celebrated their 45th wedding anniversary in June, have two daughters and six grandchildren. They live at 6636 W. Chambers Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53210.

We congratulate Eddie Schimek and are happy to present this award for his many years of dedication to and participation in the sport of horseshoe pitching.

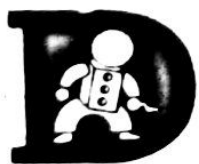

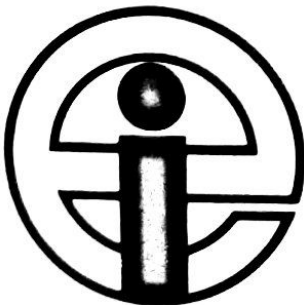

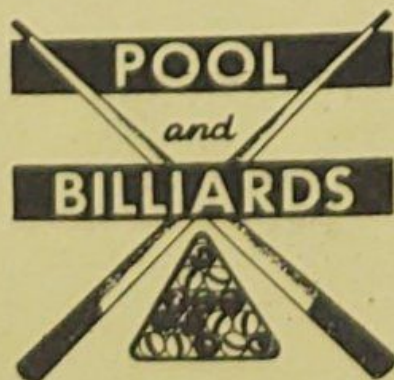
