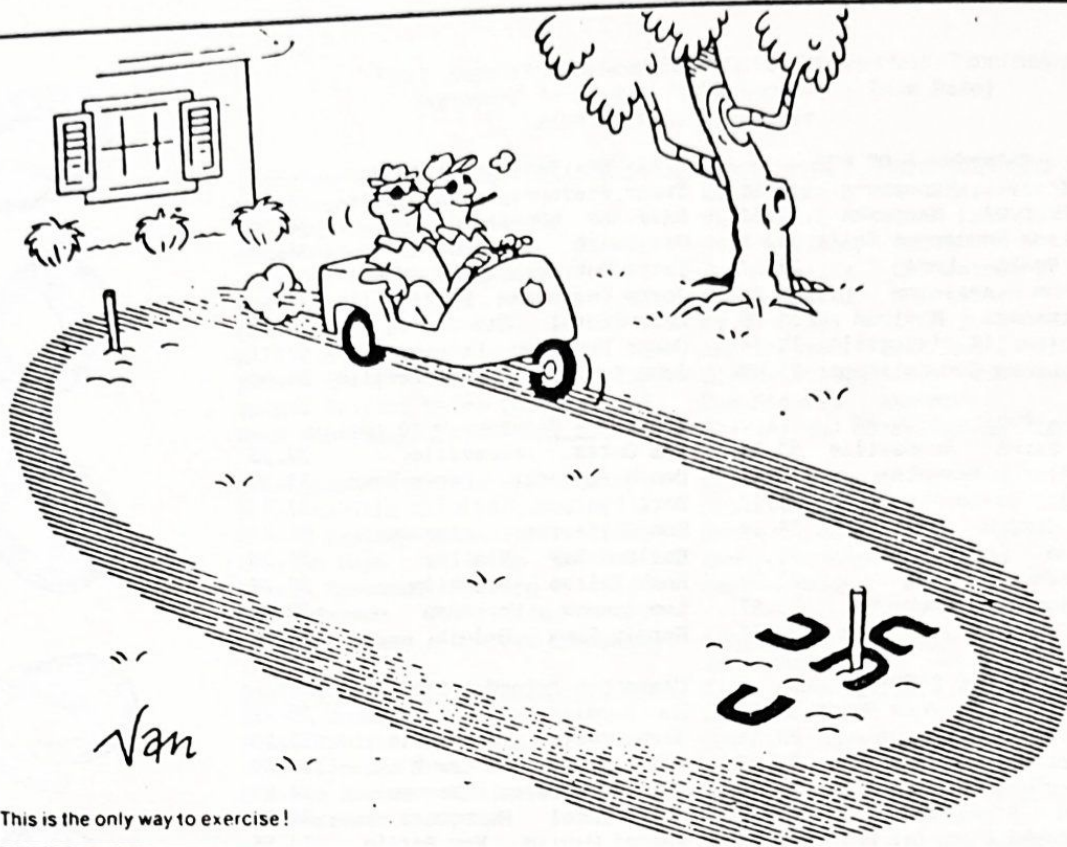
Special reminder to all participants:

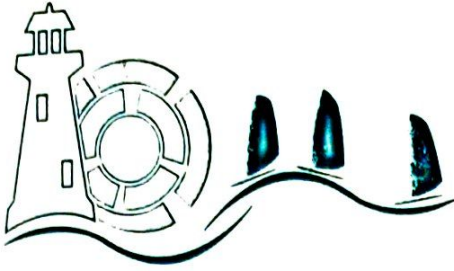
