WHPA Spring Meeting

April 18, 2026—Lake Delton Sportsmen Club

Call to order by President Dobie at 1:00 pm. Dobie led us into the Pledge of Allegiance. There were 39 in attendance.

Secretary John Secord read the minutes of the 2025 Fall Meeting and they were accepted as read. John also gave the treasurer's report. The beginning balance on October 2025 was \$7,684.94 and ending balance as of today is \$9,866.99. Treasurers report was accepted as read.

Dave Volz gave the 1st VP report. Pre-World singles tournament will have mixed classes and there was not enough pitchers and the various classes to not be mixed. Seventy-four total entries. Juniors and cadets will be one class. There will be two shifts and scorekeepers for each shift. John Secord mentioned that he had an odd number of entries and needed one more team for Walking Doubles. Steve Basso volunteered and Dobie said she would be his partner. Our website, "whpahorseshoes.com" the most views in April were for the World Tournament and then Team World. Under the World Tournament there is information about motels, camping, registration, the HOF Banquet, ordering shirts and World Tournament Tips. As of April 18, 2026 there were 658 entries to the World Tournament and 153 entries from Wisconsin.

Dan Newkirk gave the 2nd VP report. The 2026 state will be Labor Day weekend at the Beloit Club. They have 13 outdoor and 6 indoor courts. The Telfer Park setup started yesterday and Dan asked for help going forward. State shirts are in the process of being made.

Sonia Cook gave the 3rd VP report. Junior Scholarship fund. Current liabilities as of October 18, 2025 are \$5,850.00 and balance of \$12,503.95. This breaks down to 15 scholarships at \$150.00 and 12 scholarships at \$300.00. Balance as of April 18, 2026 is \$12,546.04, liabilities at \$5,850.00. Sonia also mentioned that she is running the raffle again and welcomes donations. She already has 20 donations.

Dobie Gutweiler Newsletter Editor – Dustin Duerr

(distribution) was not present, but Dobie read a note from him the mailed newsletter price of subscription is now 25.00 a year. Fred Lane mentioned how well the Newsletter looks and is really put together well. Dobie also mentioned that Kevin and Karla Brekke do the Layout and they spend countless hours making sure it is done well. Even during computer and family issues. Dobie also asked to give Kevin and Karla a hand for all they do. Kevin thanked everyone for the kind words and to those that help proof the newsletter.

Jeff Secord our Hall of Fame chairman announced that the 2026 Inductees to the Wisconsin Hall of Fame this year are Ken Heinritz, Steve Weigert and Dave Volz.

Jeff also mentioned that Team World is full, 24 teams. To get the 24th team, Missouri entered a 7th team. Notable entries - Canada is coming along with Washington and Florida one from Michigan. This is the 40th anniversary of Team World. Missouri one team will be tough to beat as their team average is 80 percent.

Old Business –

Proposed by-law change one. The change basically states that a pitcher from outside of Wisconsin can pitch in the Wisconsin State Tournament if they participate in sanctioned leagues in Wisconsin and have the required number of tournaments to qualify. There was much lively discussions, and after those, the proposed by-law change was defeated.

Proposed by-law change two. Natstats is no longer and has been replaced by Eshoe. Need to change the verbiage in the bylaws. This passed.

Proposed by-law change three. To include Elder Women and Elder Men vs just Elders in the by-laws for the state tournament. This passed.

Proposed by-law change four. Currently the Spring Meeting along with election of officers is the 3rd Saturday in April. The proposal addresses moving the meeting to the 2nd

Saturday of April. This will address getting help on 3rd weekend in April for setup at Telfer Park in Beloit for Team World. The proposal also included moving the Fall Meeting to the 2nd Saturday in October. This passed. This will go into effect starting with the Spring Meeting in 2027.

Proposed by-law change five. Current by-law - State Doubles tournament – if a junior pays to enter cannot receive money and it would go to the Junior Scholarship Fund. Change would allow Junior to collect prize monies or give to the Junior Scholarship Fund. This passed.

New Business –

World Tournament delegates – Dave Volz, Dobie Gutweiler, Dan Newkirk, Ken Heinritz, Sonia Cook, Jeff Secord.

National Officer election - 4th VP Barb Carson (incumbent) is running against Dan Goers. This position does the sanctioned tournaments and is regional director.

World Tournament committee – Sonia Cook – The NHPA runs the World Tournament (There will be signups for scorekeeping each shift. On Saturday the 11th, there will be a pre-tournament. Sign-up is at 9am to pitch at 10am). The host does everything else. Many people are needed for setup and teardown. There will be a registration table to be handled and nightly cleaning. Each opportunity will have different shifts. There will also be in-between shifts cleaning and making sure everything is ready for the next shift. On Sunday morning the 19th, that is the convention time. There will be a chapel service after that, and the Hall of Fame Banquet in the evening. If there is open pitching during the day, they will need clean-up after. There will be fun games non-horseshoe available during the tournament. Check with the registration table. Ask about the duck hunt... There will be no alcohol on the grounds. Parking will be free.

Our Fall Meeting will be on October 17, 2026 at the Sportsman's Club.

Meeting adjourned at 2:39.

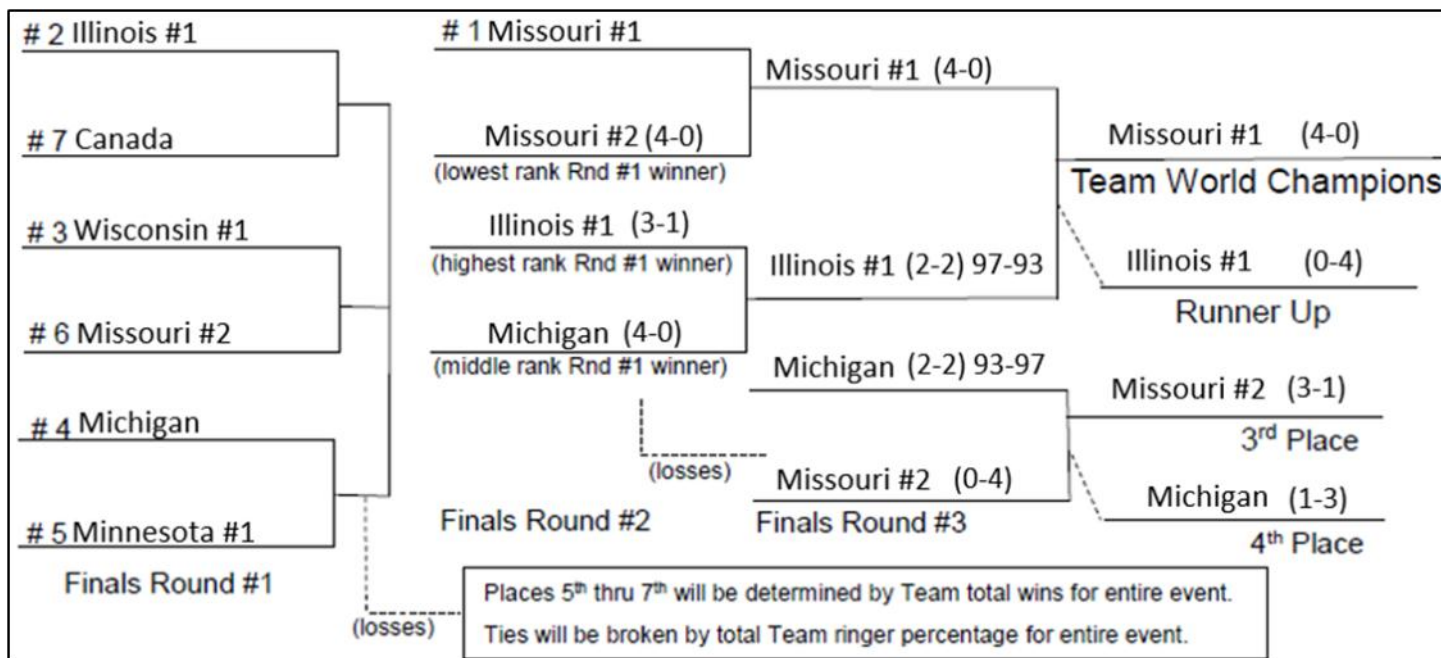
