Ken Jaeger **2005 Hall of Fame** **Inductee**

Ken was born to a large family of seven brothers and three sisters, which were all born and raised on a dairy farm. In 1972 he married his devoted and supportive wife Kathy, who also came from a family of nine. In 1973 they had a son, and named him Ken

also known as Ken Jr., who in later years became three time WHPA State Jr. Champion.

Ken was employed at Allis Chalmers, in Appleton, WI. for 30 years, where he was a Journeyman, welder fitter. He fabricated heavy machinery, such as paper machinery, rock crushers, portable plants, asphalt plants, huge loop conveyors for unloading ships, and pumps that would pump 200,000 gallons of water a minute. He currently is employed at Waupaca County Highway as a Welder-Fabricator.

Ken and his brothers would pitch shoes for the fun of it when they were kids, when a leaner was 2 points. When his dad would go visit his brothers in Gillette, WI, he never got to pitch shoes, so often just watched them hoot and holler, and enjoying their big bottle of beer. Those were the days! Ken got started pitching in 1978 at his open house party, when he lost seven dollars, pitching games to 21 points.

In 1979 he joined the Wolf River Ringers Club, which was had members strong. He has been a true worker/leader in the horseshoe world as evidenced by his participation on many levels. He served two terms as Club President, four years as Club Treasurer, Tournament Director of the Wolf River Open since its start in 1991, and Sanction League Director for the past six years. Has hosted and co-hosted NHPA sanctioned tournaments in Plover and Eagle River. He has served as assistant regional director, and enjoyed being President of the WHPA for eight years. For the past two years, he has been the Wisconsin Charter 28 Regional Director. He worked with Chippewa Valley Visitors Bureau, Eau Claire Club, Jane Smith and Ken Kosky in 1999 to put in a bid to host the World Tournament in 2002. The bid for the World Tournament was secured for 2003. He enjoyed helping hosting the 2003 World Tournament, because he was working with good friends of horseshoes.

Ken, along with Ken Kosky, were the brains behind the tournament. Their leadership pulled many horseshoe people together for a common goal... a successful World tournament in Wisconsin.

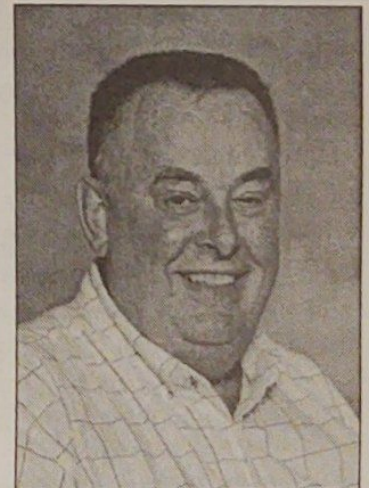
Not only was Ken a promoter of one of life's best games but also a participant. He pitched his first WHPA Tournament in 1981 and first State Tournament in 1982 and has pitched in every one since... for decades! While pitching horseshoes his high tournament was 60.22 %. He has held around a 50 to 55 % average for the past few years, and has won five class A sanction tournaments. He has also pitched at World tournaments and served as a Wisconsin delegate at the National Convention.

In his spare time he designed, constructed and donated about 25 portable courts for fund raisers at a variety of horseshoe events.

Anyone who has spent time at horseshoe tournaments has had the pleasure of visiting and knowing a very fine man. Congratulations Ken Jaeger, you are a deserving inductee into the Wisconsin Hall of Fame.

Ken Kosky **2005 Hall of Fame** **Inductee**

Ken Kosky was born July 7, 1944 in Iron River, MI, a small town of about 2500 residents in the UP of Michigan. He is the oldest (wisest) of 4 children, having 1 brother and 2 sisters. He grew up on a small farm about 10 miles out of town. Being the oldest,



he got an early dose of working with his father on a wide range of chores, including milking cows, operating farm equipment, logging, and truck driving. In 1962, after high school graduation he left home to attend school in Milwaukee. After graduating with an Associate degree in Diesel Engineering, he moved to Chicago where he worked in a steel warehouse for a couple of years. In 1965, he went to work for the Cummins Engine Co distributorship where they specialized in component rebuilding. That led to a job for an independent repair shop in Green Bay in 1970 and eventually back to Cummins in DePere, WI in 1973. In 1968, he married. He has three children, Terri, Michael, and Jason. In May of 1977 we opened our

doors for a diesel fuel system repair shop in Wausau, WI. Sons, Mike and Jason, are working with Ken today and are gradually taking over the the business.

He started playing horseshoes in a bar league in about 1982. Gus After traveling with Gus for several years, he persuaded to buy a card and enter a tournament. His first was in New London and the rest is history as he has attended as many as 20 tournaments in one year. In 1994 the Windy Hill Horseshoe Club was formed and Ken was the President for 10 years. An annual NHPA sanctioned tournament began in 1994 with as many as 94 pitchers for the weekend. ANHPA sanctioned league began in 1996 and Ken was the league secretary/director until 2003. He has attended the World Tournament for 10 of the past 13 years and won a Class Championship in 1994 in Syracuse, NY. Not only was Ken a pitcher but was the man behind the scenes as he received I received the Presidents Award from President Ken Jaeger in 2000. The State Tournament was held in Wausau in 1997, 2000, and 2002 when Ken served as the State tournament director in 1997 and the co-director in 2000 and 2002. Ken was very instrumental in working with Ken Jaeger in planning and organizing the World Tournament in Eau Claire. These two gentlemen were tireless organizers and workers with the Eau Claire WT committee. Without them, the success of the tournament would have been questionable.

In 1999 a new style printer for doing some things in business was purchased. It was also ideal for doing printing the WI Horseshoe Newsletter. Rick Poppe and Jim Haupt knew there would be a need for a publisher of the WI Newsletter. Ken became the Publisher of the best horseshoe newsletter in the country thanks to Jim Haupt's efforts.

Because Ken is a man who never sits still, he bought the horseshoe sales business from Cliff Troullier. For the next several years was a distributor under Curly Seibol.

In 2001, Ken developed his own web site and started selling horseshoes over the internet.

In 2004, Ken was appointed the Director of NHPA Game Related Sales taking over from Ed Domey.

Ken Kosky has definitely earned membership in the Wisconsin Hall of Fame for the many services he donates to better the game of horseshoe. Congratulations Ken!
