

Membership in the Whpa/ NHPA will allow you to compete in sanctioned events throughout the U.S. and Canada including your State Championships and the World Championships as well as local sanctioned leagues and tournaments. There are seven pitching divisions, men's, women's, elders, junior boys, junior girls, cadet boys and cadet girls. Annual membership dues for the Whpa/Nhpa are \$35 for adults and \$5 for junior/cadets. More information can be found on the Whpa website under New Members Information.



The Whpa oversees Sanctioned Events in Wisconsin – Any horseshoe pitching event which has been recognized and approved by the Nhpa and/or Charter Regional Directors and for which the results and records will be accepted, recorded, and published by the NHPA through eShoe. This includes leagues, tournaments, and special events.



The standard method of play for sanctioned tournaments is round robin play with contestants seeded in classes by Tournament Directors based on their current ringer percentage. Generally there are 6 to 8 pitchers per class and to keep classes more competitive with closer ringer percentages they usually have mixed division classes. Most games consist of 40 shoes per pitcher. A pitcher's ringer percentage (for a game, tournament, or eShoe) is determined by dividing the total number of ringers by the total number of shoes pitched. A pitcher's current ringer percent in eShoe is based on the three highest Nhpa sanctioned events in the preceding twelve months or among the last ten events during that same period.

There are between 50 and 60 sanctioned tournaments run every year in Wisconsin with indoor facilities for the winter months. The tournament schedule and calendar with court location and Tournament Directors contact information can also be found on the Whpa website. You must be a Whpa/Nhpa member to participate in sanctioned tournaments.

The Whpa State Singles Championship Tournament is held on labor day weekend each year. All entrants must be a legal resident of Wisconsin at least (6) months prior to the State Tournament and be a Whpa/Nhpa member. The entry deadline is July 31st and all adult entrants must have pitched in (3) Nhpa sanctioned tournaments in Wisconsin in the (12) months prior to the entry deadline. The State Tournament will include classes for Men, Women, Junior Boys, Junior Girls, Cadet Boys, Cadet Girls and Elder Men. The State Tournament entry form can be found on the Whpa website when it becomes available. The State Tournament location is voted on by the membership at the Whpa Fall Meeting (2) years in advance. The Whpa Junior Scholarship Fund awards the Junior Boy and Junior Girl State Champion a \$300 scholarship each and the second place finishers a \$150 scholarship each.
