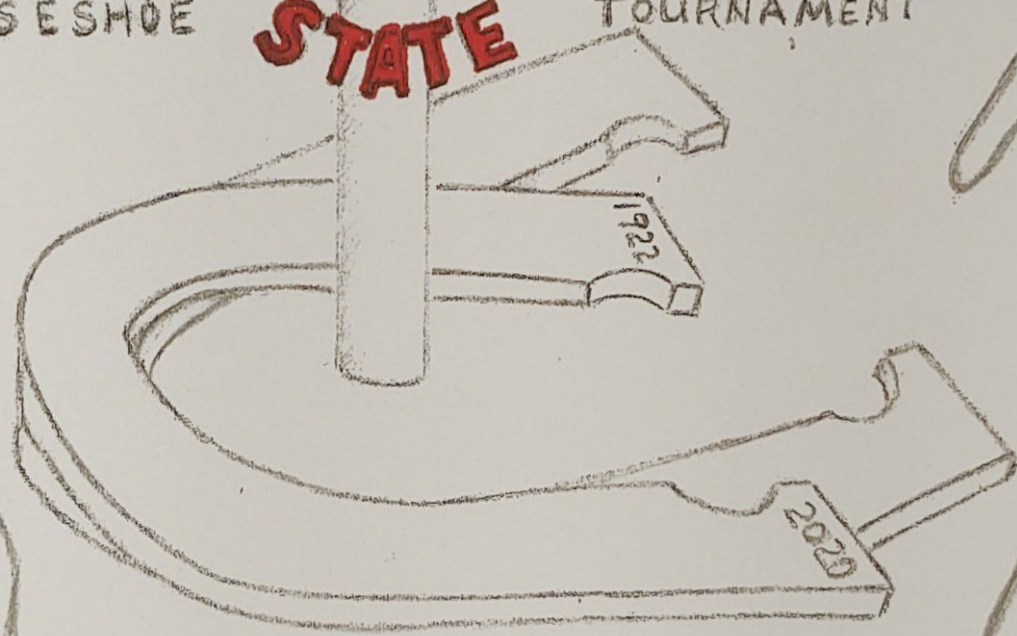

### **Early History of Beloit Horseshoe Club**

Horseshoe Pitching:

From Backyard Game to International Competition – In Beloit

Horseshoe pitching has long been a popular sport in Beloit. According to the late Beloit Daily New Historian, Lawrence Raymer, "There was a time when there were courts all over the city, and almost every family played horseshoes in their backyard." Several local industries had horseshoe courts built on their premises to provide recreation for their workers. Fairbanks Morse, Beloit Corporation, Besley Welles and Warner Brake held horseshoe tournaments at their annual picnics.

In 1955, at the Wisconsin State Tournament held at the Stat Fairgrounds in West Allis, Earl Ramquist won the State Championship. Earl is the only Beloit to have held the State title. Ben Brostuen won the State Class C title in 1969 and the Class B title in 1975. At the state tournament at Eau Claire, WI in 1990 Earl Ramquist was inducted into the Wisconsin State Horseshoe Pitcher's Hall of Fame.

In the early 1960'S Ben Brostuen built a regulation clay court in his backyard. He invited some of the better players from out of town to provide competition. They came from Milwaukee, Lake Geneva, Freeport and other surrounding areas to compete with some of the better players in Beloit.

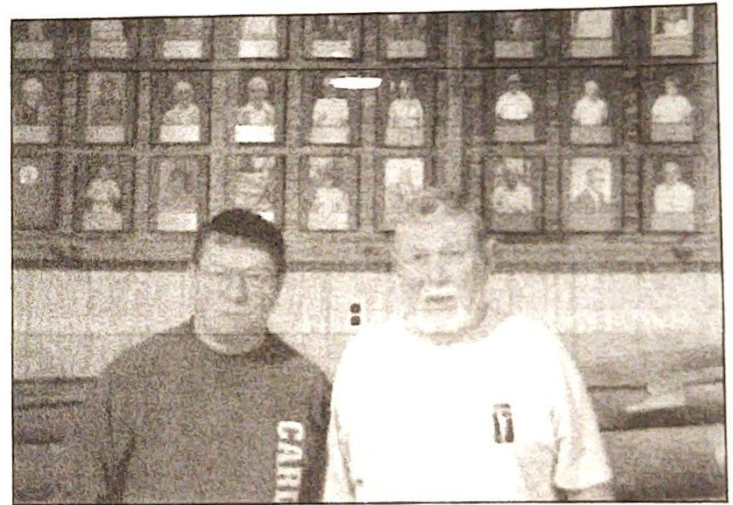
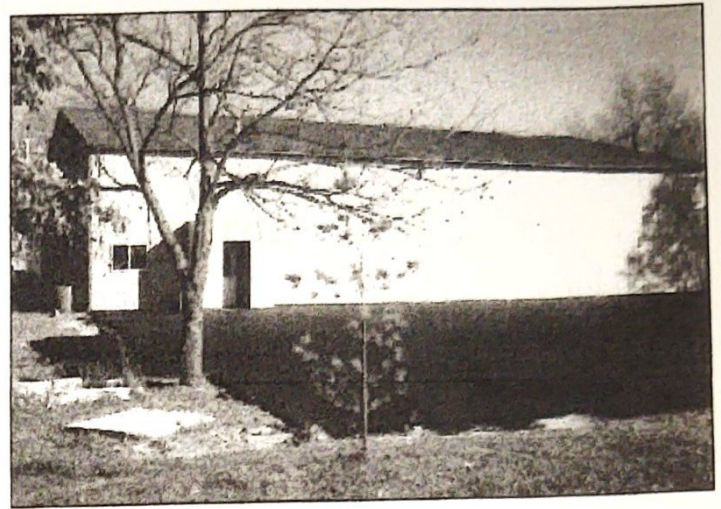
In the late 1950's earl Ramquist, Al Walmsley, Ben Brostuen and others built 8 clay courts with cement walkways at the Vernon Avenue Playgrounds. These courts were used until the mid-1960's when due to vandalism and lack of maintenance it was felt a private home would be a better place and would result in better maintenance of the courts.

About 1967 Don Goldsmith and his father built 4 regulation clay courts on their land just off Shirland Avenue on Fisher Road in South Beloit. These courts were built in the nice shady area and were used every Tuesday evening and Saturday afternoon until the mid 1980's. There were no organized leagues but each fall and annual doubles tournament was held with pitchers coming from Janesville, Milton, Edgerton, Rockford, Freeport and the surrounding areas. Some of the local competitors were, Earl Ramquist, Ben Brostuen, Art Larson, Claire Everson, Charlie Goldsmith, Jack Ramsey, Bob Geeser, Don Goldsmith, Ivan Borkenhagen, Bob Kamppi, Doug Goldsmith, Al Knutson, Pete Thorson, Alden Brostuen, Bueben Brostuen, and Al Walmesley.

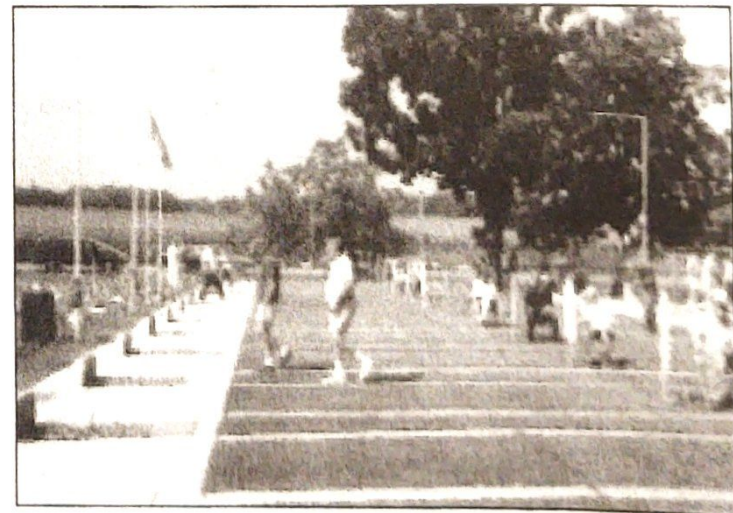
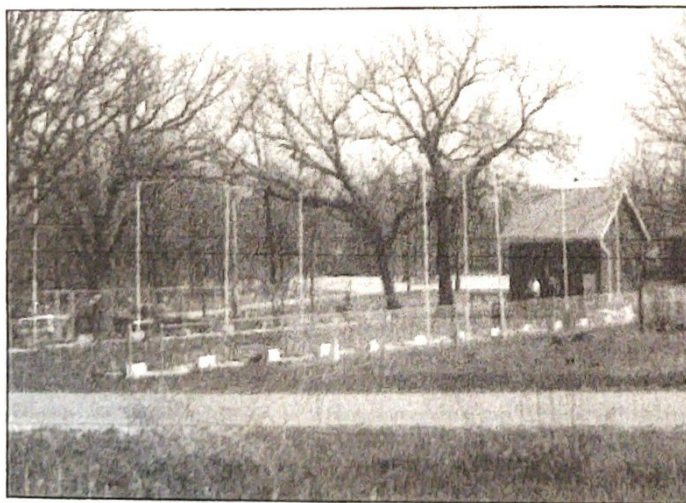

## Dave Forseth – 2020 WHPA Hall of Fame Member

Dave Forseth was born December 12, 1942, in the Township of Arena, Wisconsin. He was the fourth of 5 children in his family. Dave had 2 sisters and 2 brothers. Dave and his wife, Gail, have 4 children; 3 sons: Robin, Randy, and Rick; and 1 daughter, Katie. Dave and Gail also have 4 grandsons, 2 granddaughters, and 2 great grandsons. Dave and Gail live on their family farm along with their daughter. They have had the farm since 1982 and raise beef cattle.

Dave began pitching horseshoes in 1976 shortly after The Sandbar on Highway 14 in Arena opened. Dave was part of a Traveling League where they competed with teams from other bars in the area. Members of the Sandbar team included Bob Reeves, Milt Husom, LeRoy Husom, Ray White, Jerry White, Dick White and Dave Forseth. The team played at this location until 1990, the year The Sandbar Sports Arena opened. Dave and the team built eight indoor courts, had league 2 nights a week and tournaments on weekends. News spread about the indoor courts and Norm Mauthe got wind of it and came to Arena to check out the facility. Norm eventually talked the group into becoming NHPA sanctioned. Norm also built the score boards for the courts.

The Sandbar Sports Arena became a "hot spot" for the WHPA. The WHPA officers needed to find a new home for the Hall of Fame when the Royal Wood Sports Arena in Plover was not going to run horseshoe tournaments there anymore. Dave was more than accommodating to bring the Hall of Fame displays into the Sandbar and host State meetings. In 1999, Dave and fellow "Sandbaggers" hosted the Border Battle with Minnesota. Wisconsin won 70 games to Minnesota's 58. Members of that team were: 40' players: Randy Rein, Don Kangas, John Udelhofen, Kent Anderson, John Crook, Gus Schram, John Koepp, and Ron Brockway; and 30' players: Clayton Gage, Gert Wilcziek, Ralph Maylahn, Lorraine Sternberg, Edie McKinney, Elaine Troullier, Jane Smith, Sue Helene. The Sandbar was also the site for hosting three WHPA State Tournaments, 2000, 2003, and 2007, on their indoor courts and the expanded outdoor courts. Dave was active with hosting and helping run each of these events.

Dave received the President's Award in 2003 by President Ken Jaeger for recognition of his contributions to the WHPA.

Dave had shoulder replacement in 2011 and no longer plays horseshoes. Dave's other hobbies are airplane flying and boating. Dave has made many friendships through his involvement in horseshoes. He is honored to be inducted into the Hall of Fame.

The Hall Of Fame Committee extends their congratulations to Dave Forseth for being the 2020 inductee into the WHPA Hall of Fame.
