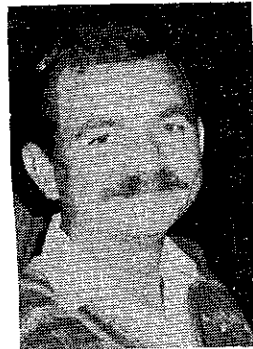



STATE MEETING

WE'RE ON A ROLL....,LET'S GO FOR 1992

The annual State Meeting convened at the V.F.W. in Beloit. One of the past stumbling blocks, State Tournament site selection, was no problem. Eau Claire tendered a bid for 1990. The WHPA members jumped at the opportunity. Ed Ballwanz, president of the Fond du Lac club offered their fairground site for 1991. He was just starting to sell the sixteen courts when the delegation accepted the Fond du Lac bid. Things were clicking right along. Ken Jaeger called out "We're on a roll....,Let's go for 1992."

Although no more State Tournament sites were selected, the forty-seven in attendance voiced their approval of other meaningful proposals.

Dick Hansen noted the newly accepted guidelines for the State Approved List were not being followed by all tournament directors. His particular complaint is that some tournament results are not filed with the state secretary within the fourteen day limit and some others have not paid the fifty cents, per adult pitcher, fee. He asked for a suggested method of enforcement. Considering that all tournament directors signed an agreement, last spring, to uphold the four guidelines, the members saw fit to empower the executive board to omit the listing of tournaments not in compliance from the State Approved Schedule.

Following an appeal from the staff of the Newsletter, it was agreed by voice vote that 'official' letters, flyers, announcements, tournament schedules, and mail heretofore required of the WHPA to its members, be replaced by official publication in the Wisconsin Horseshoe Newsletter.

The Hansen garage, it has proved, is not spacious enough for the Hall of Fame display. Susie Pritzlaff offered and the WHPA members assembled accepted, to have the Lone Star Tavern become the temporary home for the H.O.F display. It maybe there will be room for the scrapbooks along with the plaques.

Lorraine Sternberg, coordinator for the Junior Scholarship Fund is concerned with the container contributions made in 1989. She urged clubs to try new ideas to place more focus on the Fund contributions during tournaments. One suggestion was to appoint an individual from each tournament committee to spark new interest in the 'Fund' Contributions were down this year from the usual \$1000 to \$721 from all sources.

Claretta Hansen said junior pitchers participation North of Hwy. 8 has taken a dramatic upswing since Jane Smith began teaching horseshoes in summer school. Smith says you could do it too. A teaching certificate is not required. She advises getting the Community Education people interested; then begin recruiting in the schools. Smith ran 40 to 50 youngsters through a three week course and has some new tournament entries because of it. She beleives in separating the kids under 10 yr. into a "young jr. class".

Dick Hansen called Donnie Roberts for the date of the ESPN show of the World Tournament. They will air the video four times, the first being **OCTOBER 20TH FROM 8:00 TO 9:00 PM**

We re-elected Curt Bestul to 2nd V.P. and Dick Hansen to President without hesitation. Bestul said he would not mind if another nomination was introduced. He's willing to share the responsibility of board membership with others.

Before adjourning we helped recognize the host club. Beloit's officers: Bud Renley, Ken Lovass, Earl Paulson, and Harold Laws received a deserving and meaningful round of applause from the WHPA.

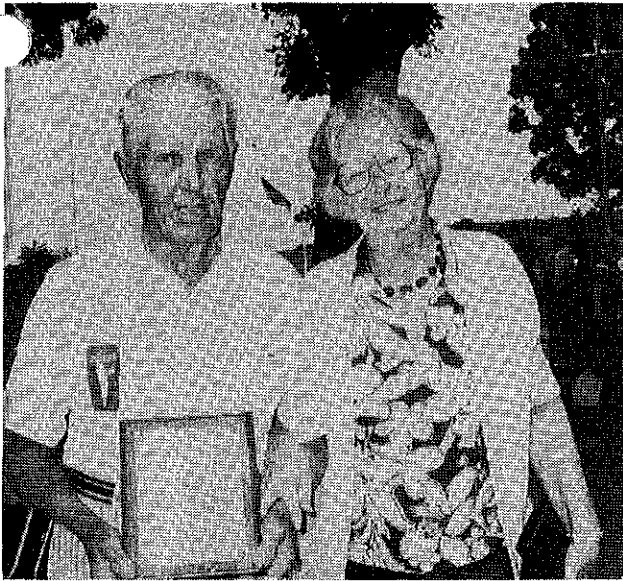



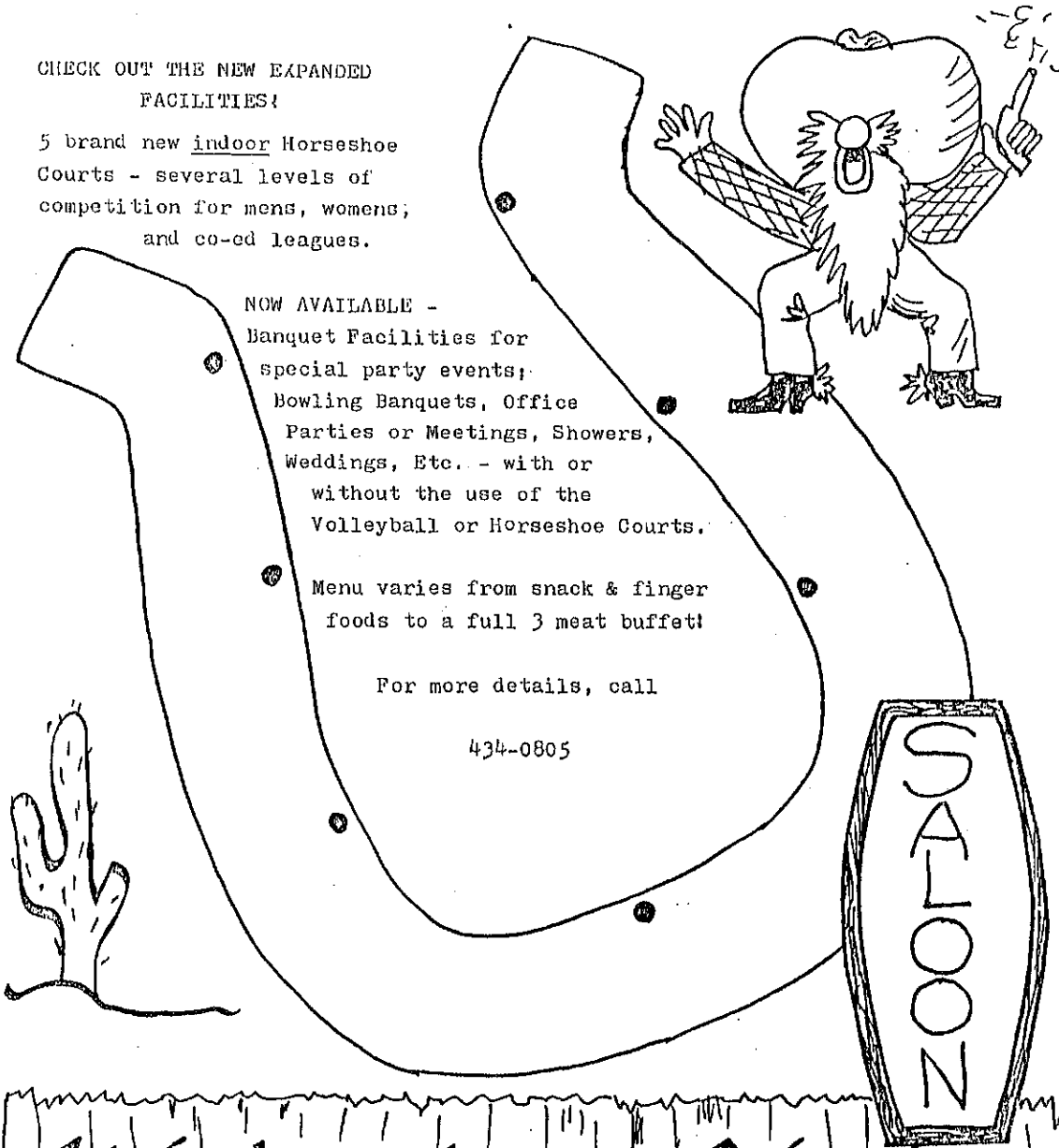
