# HORSESHOE TRIVIA

The origin of horseshoe pitching is uncertain, but the game may have derived from the ancient Greek sport of discus throwing, for it is known that Roman soldiers and camp followers used horseshoes in the same manner that the Greek athletes used the discus. As the modern game evolved, the shoes were thrown for accuracy rather than distance, and stakes were added.

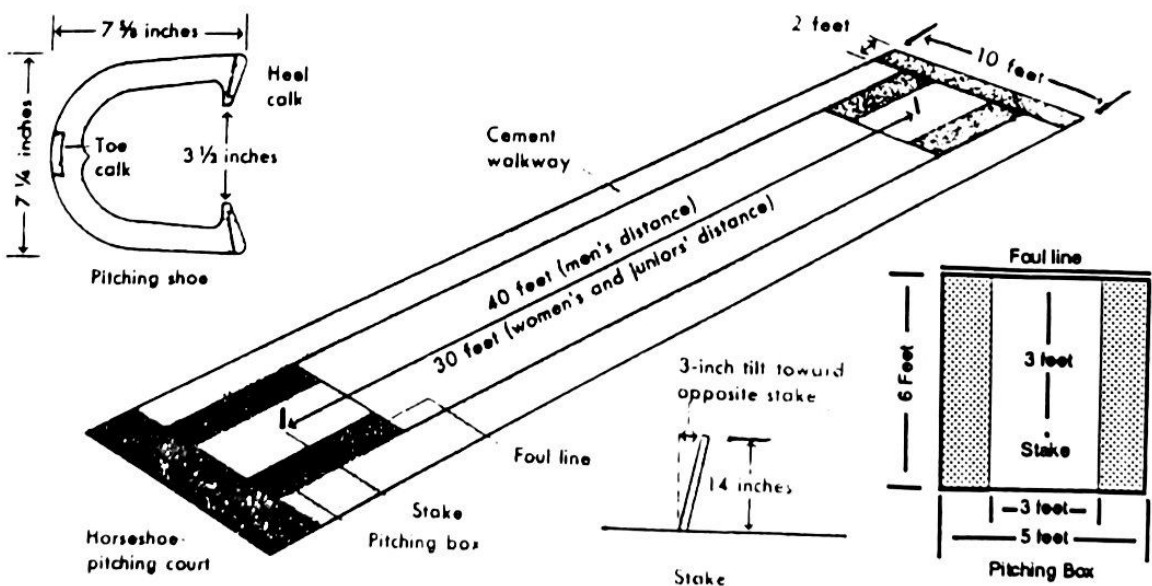
The game was introduced in America by soldiers of the British colonial garrisons, and during the American Revolutionary War pitching horseshoes was a popular diversion among both British and American soldiers.

Horseshoe pitching was developed into a very relaxing but competitive sport during the twentieth century.

In 1920, George May of Akron, Ohio, developed a technique of pitching horseshoes in which he controlled the spin of the shoe and facilitated the throwing of ringers. Higher ringer percentages soon followed.

A shoe may not exceed 7-1/2 inches in length, 7 inches in width or 2-1/2 pounds in weight.

An official game consists of 50 points; an informal game 21 points. The governing organization is the National Horseshoe Pitchers Association of America, founded in 1915.

# HAROLD SCHEETS

Harold Scheets had been pitching horseshoes only four years when he captured his first state title, at the age of 17, in 1932. He was top qualifier with a score of 465. The 32 top qualifiers out of a field of 70 were divided into four groups of eight to play in the semi-finals.

In 1933, at the tenth annual Wisconsin Horseshoe Tournament at State Fair Park, he successfully defended his title and broke two national records while doing it. Harold averaged 74.6% for 15 round robin games and paired with his opponent to get four dead on 15 occasions. He went through the tournament without the loss of a game.

In 1934 Harvey Elmeron regained the state title which he had held for six years before losing it to Scheets in 1932.

Harold did not pitch in State again until 1971 when he won first with 51.7% in Class B in a playoff with Norb Gossens. In 1972 he came out third with 68.4 in Class A in a three-way tie for second with Wally Saeger and Curt Bestul.

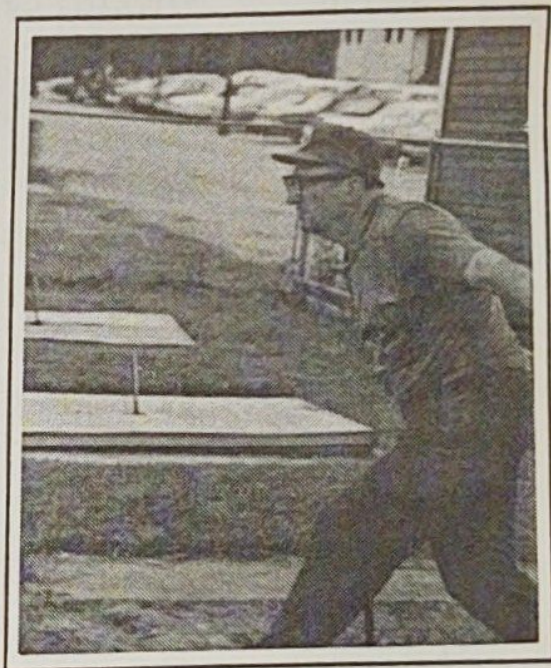
In 1973 at Combined Locks, forty years after winning his second state championship, he won first with 65.4% in a three-way playoff. Ralph Maylahn placed second with 67.4% and Carl Joppe third with 64.7%.

At Fond du Lac in 1974 Harold came out third (66.3) after Bill Glass who had 72.3%, and Ralph Maylahn, 69.4%.

At Watertown in 1975 he had a perfect record of 11 and 0 with 70% ringers.

He repeated at Combined Locks the next year with a 6 and 1 record and 65.7%.

Nineteen seventy-six is the last time Harold Scheets pitched in a Wisconsin State Tournament. He now resides in San Diego, California.



# DARLENE EBERT

Darlene Ebert started pitching horseshoes in the 1960s and in 1965 was instrumental in organizing the Fillmore Horseshoe Club. She and her husband, Dan, built six courts in their backyard. There now are nine regulation clay courts.

In 1972, her first year of tournament pitching, Darlene won the Goldendale Open, Sussex Open, Winnebagoland at Fond du Lac, the Mideastern Wisconsin at Combined Locks, and her first State title at Green Bay.



Her 1972 and 1973 state championships were won with 7 and 0 records and ringer percentages of 51.3 and 59.5. In 1974 she tied with Pat Eaton at 4 and 1 and won in a playoff with 50.8%. Her 1975 title was won with a 5 and 0 record and 60.4%.

Darlene is very active in running the annual Fillmore U.S.A. Open. She helped organize and has played in a Fillmore Couples League for over 15 years. She was secretary, statistician, and advisor for the Fillmore Club from

1968 to 1984. She is listed in Ottilie Reno's book AMERICAN DIRECTOR OF HORSESHOE PITCHING.

In addition to being a homemaker, she owns and operates a successful trophy business called TROPHIES U.S.A., making many trophies for bowling, softball and, of course, horseshoe.

Darlene was born December 8, 1933 and married Ron Ebert in 1957. They have one son, Greg, who pitches occasionally, daughter-in-law Susan and granddaughter Alysha. Her husband and four brothers are still active in pitching horseshoes. Her mother, Esther Vogt, was elected to the Horseshoe Hall of Fame in 1986 at the age of 82.

We congratulate Darlene on her years of involvement in the sport of horseshoe pitching.
